## CBA Nomination Information

To be eligible for a Community Builders Award of Excellence the company, organization or individual must:

- Reside in and service the City of Greater Sudbury
- Be established in the community for a minimum of 3 years

## Nomination Process

Nominations are judged by an independent panel of judges, collectively representing expertise in all award categories. The judges' decisions are final.

Winners will be notified in writing at least 30 days prior to the awards gala. A video will be produced showcasing each winner and will be aired at the gala as well as on regional television. A souvenir magazine will also be produced and distributed at the end of the awards gala.

All nomination packages remain property of the Community Builders Awards of Excellence program.

Nominations can be updated and re-submitted the following year.

## Nominations must include the following to qualify:

- 1 Completed nomination form
- 2 300 – 500 word summary of the nominee's achievements in the category. This should highlight specific initiatives that support the nominee's impact on the Greater Sudbury community.
- 3 Answers to the following questions, separate from the summary:
  1. How will this individual or group be remembered by future generations for their contributions?
  2. What qualifies this individual or group as a visionary, having impact on the community of Greater Sudbury?
- 4 Detail any awards, honours or other special recognition given to the nominee.
- 5 Collect a minimum of two letters (maximum of 10 letters) of support. These letters can come from colleagues, clients, political officials and so on. The nominator is not permitted to provide a letter of support.
- 6 4 unbound copies of the nomination must be provided by the deadline date.

## Awards Category Descriptions **COMMUNITY BUILDERS** Awards of Excellence

### Arts

The award goes to the individual or group that has helped make the Artistic community stronger. They have championed an individual, an event, an idea, an ethic, or philosophy that has made us stronger and better.

### Economic Development

The award goes to an individual or group that has had an important impact on the economic well-being of the community. They have chaired and led a committee, they have helped bring new business to town, or they are responsible for putting infrastructure in place.

### Education

This award goes to the student, teacher, administrator, or education advocate (i.e. parent) who has made a difference in the City of Greater Sudbury. It could be an extraordinary teacher who has changed the direction of students' lives, an administrator who established a specialized program, or an advocate who saved a school from closing.

### Environment

This award recognizes an individual or group that has had an important and positive impact on our environment, both man-made and natural. It may be a private initiative (i.e. an innovative energy efficient home), or a public one (i.e. the greening of Sudbury or the cleaning up of Junction Creek). What all projects will have in common is that they demonstrate to the rest of us what is possible in improving the environmental footprint in our community.

### Health Care

The award goes to an individual or group that has had an important impact on the health care of the community. It could be as straight forward as a health care professional who has gone beyond their call of duty, or the individual who helped establish a palliative care program that would not exist without their leadership.

### Sports & Recreation

The award goes to the individual or group that has contributed to the strength of sports in Greater Sudbury. They have inspired people (a coach), established a program (a league or playground), mentored a team or an individual to extraordinary accomplishment, or set an example for many to carry in their hearts.

### Young Leader

The award goes to an individual or group, under 25 years of age, as of February 16, 2012, actively involved in worthwhile community service, in any one of the Community Builders categories. Recipients are young leaders who show a commitment in making their community better for others.

### Hall of Fame

The award goes to an individual or group that has had a significant impact on the Greater Sudbury community. People who can be credited with the establishment of an institution (a theatre centre, a festival, a park, a greening project).
